The European Federation for Welding, Joining and Cutting (EFW) and the Croatian Welding Society (CWS) Invite everyone involved in welding and joining technology to take part in EUROJOIN 8. The eighth European Conference on Joining Technology will be held in May 24 – 26, 2012. The venue is in Pula, Hotel Histria.

The aim is meeting of experts and researchers, presentation of related papers and other accompanying events. Conference will provide favourable environment for exchange of experiences, survey of the state of the art and future trends in the field.

Apart from the Conference itself, a number of accompanying events will be organized such as: exhibition of filler materials, equipment for welding and allied techniques. Workshop for welding coordinators will be organized and EFW will elect the best welding Coordinator.

Official languages at the Conference will be Croatian and English. **WORKSHOP** – During Eurojoin 7 meeting in Venice, the best European Welding Coordinator has been appointed. It is our opinion that there is a large number of experienced welding coordinators in Europe. Therefore, this workshop has been organized as a meeting point where coordinators will have an opportunity to exchange their experience, while other participants have a chance to get information on different approaches to coordination of welding activities and inspection of welding operations. Welding coordinators are experts certified for coordination and their recertification is requested after 3 years period while supervising engineers are experts that acquired their qualification through IWE/EWE diploma, but are not qualified for coordination.

**Pula** is the largest city in Istria, western Croatia, located on southern tip of the Istrian peninsula. Pula was once an Austro-Hungarian Empire major naval base. Nowadays, it is an important Croatian port and an industrial centre being something in between a busy working port and active Istrian Riviera town. The Romans captured Pula in 178 B.C. where they built the most amazing and well-known Pula amphitheatre, which remains are still used as Pula's summer stage for various opera and pop performances, as well as for well-known Pula Film Festival that is hosted there since 1953. The amphitheatre was built at the end of first century B.C. It is sixth largest amphitheatre in the world, with capacity of 22 000 visitors. Outer shell is almost complete, while inside seats are just partly preserved. During the history, Pula was destroyed by Augustus, but was rebuilt by him and named Pietas Julia. **The Brijuni islands**, were proclaimed a **national park** in 1983 They cover an area of 2,700 acres, and total of fourteen larger and small islands, of which the largest are Veliki and Mali Brijun. Brijuni National Park is an oasis of the magnificent harmony between man, animal and plant life. There are almost 700 plant species and about 250 bird species on the islands, whereas the mild Mediterranean climate makes it a pleasant health resort.

### REACH PULA by car /by bus/ by ship / by train /by plane

#### By Car :

from the west: Trieste - Kopar - Buje – Pula  
from the north: Villach - Ljubljana - Kopar - Buje - Pula  
from the east: Zagreb - Rijeka - Tunnel Učka - Pazin - Pula

#### By Bus or by train

**Regular international bus** lines connect Croatia with all neighbouring countries, as well as Switzerland, France, Germany and Slovakia. This kind of transportation is the cheapest. Also, bus service between major cities (intercity lines) is quite frequent, as well as regional services - bus lines reach to the smallest places on the coast.

**Direct railroad lines** connect Croatia to Slovenia, Hungary, Italy, Austria, Switzerland, Slovakia, France, Germany, Bosnia and Herzegovina. With all other European countries there are indirect lines. In Croatia there are EuroCity (EC), InterCity (IC), express (Ex), fast (B) and local trains

#### By plane or by ship

If you are arriving by **regular or charter flights**, you will land at the Pula airport, the biggest international airport in Istria. The Pula airport is only 5 km away from the city centre, so you can easily get there by taxi, bus or organized transport.

**Regular travel and ferry lines** work between Italian (Venice, Trieste, Ancona, Pescara and Bari) and Croatian ports. International maritime boarder crossings are permanent (Umag, Poreč, Rovinj, Pula, Rasa-Brsica, Rijeka, Mali Lošinj, Senj, Zadar, Šibenik, Split, Ploče, Metković, Korčula and Dubrovnik)
